

The project will work as follows: From the enrolments we will assemble an european editorial team. This team will


After your application you will receive further information concerning the seminar.

The project will work as follows: From the enrolments we will assemble an european editorial team. This team will meet during a seminar at the Evangelische Jugendbildungs-stätte Hackhauser Hof in Solingen, Germany in order to decide on the subjects and contents of the newspaper. Arrangements concerning the articles will be done and the work will be organized. Then the participants will have a period of time of four weeks (please plan your time) in order to write the articles at home and to discuss with the others on an internet platform. After that there will be the last phase of the editorial work, the layout and finally the print. In spring 2009 people in the field of church youth work and school will receive the newspaper in a print version or will find it in the internet as a download file. The content of this newspaper is about the European election which will take place on 7th June 2009.



The european election decides about the constitution of the European Parliament and you can decide too. With the new treaty of Lisbon which will come into force from 2009 on the new european Parliament will gain clearly more influence and power within European policy. This is an additional reason to occupy oneself with the topics of the european election and particulary to emphasize the topics concerning young people in Europe. What is going on with the

"Structured Dialogue"? Will the "European Youth Pact" really make sure that there will be more support of young people during their vocational training and their access to the job. Which advantages and possibilities do I have as a young-ster in Europe? Youngstars examines carefully the European Parliament and discusses what young people expect from european policy. For the fifth time now a newspaper for youth work and school shall be produced in order to invite young people to think about the topics, to discuss and to meddle in european subjects.
